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


Child poverty varies widely across the county.4



Average number of Children's ER Visits for Asthma, 2009-168



The percent of 3rd-graders reading below grade level reflects large regional disparities. 11

21% Central


35% East

Economically disadvantaged 3rd-graders are 3x more likely than non-disadvantaged 3rd-graders to read below grade level.

Racial disparities are enormous. Black (49%), Latino (43%), & Pacific Islander (38%) 3rd-graders are **2-3x more likely** to read below grade level than their White (16%) peers across the county.



Federal Poverty Level vs Real Costs in Contra Costa County



Contra Costa County Poverty by Race







Low Birth Weight by Race 2015-2017 Singleton Births


Preterm Births by Race 2015-2017 Singleton Births




Fetal and Infant Loss Contra Costa County
