Donating Protective Equipment and Supplies for Healthcare Providers

Contra Costa Health Services is now accepting donations of protective equipment and supplies for use by healthcare providers throughout the county.

Businesses and residents are encouraged to donate <u>only</u> the following types of protective medical supplies:

- Eye protection, such as goggles and face shields
- Antibacterial and disinfecting wipes, typically alcohol or bleach based (unopened). NO baby wipes.
- N-95 and surgical masks (in **unopened** containers/boxes)
- Medical gowns: Disposable gowns, as well as cloth surgical and hospital gowns in good condition
