## The Contra Costa County Elections Division Needs YOU!

Poll Worker Program for County Employees November 3, 2020 General Election

Do you want to help make democracy happen for the historic November General Election? We need people like you on our Election Day team! This is your chance to play an important part in the voting process in Contra Costa.

As a poll worker, you will draw your regular County pay, plus receive a stipend of \$125 or \$230. Individuals who speak Spanish, Mandarin, or Cantonese are highly encouraged to participate and will receive an additional \$10.

To participate, you must:

- Be a <u>permanent</u> Contra Costa County employee.
- Be a registered voter in any California county or legal permanent resident who would otherwise be eligible to vote.
- Be available to work from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. anywhere in the county.
- Attend a 1-hour online training class and a 30-minute in-person outdoor training class.
- Receive approval from your Department Head or their designee.
- Wear a mask and abide by all COVID protocols when attending training and serving on Election Day.

We are working with the County Health Services to plan a healthy and safe election for all poll workers and voters. The necessary Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and sanitation supplies will be provided.
