Subject: Combined Charities Ends November 2 – Last Week to Contribute

The Countywide Combined Charities Campaign **ends on Monday, November 2**nd. If you are considering a donation, but have not made one yet, you can contribute in one of two ways:

By check or money order– Make your check payable to the **Federation** under which the Charity belongs (see *Donor Source Guide*). *Print the fillable donation form, attach your check and submit to: Jessica Butterfield at 30 Douglas Drive, Martinez CA 94553*).

By payroll deduction– The easiest method of all. Select the charity/charities you wish to support and indicate how much you want to give each pay period beginning in January 2021. Use the fillable donation form online. Your donation will automatically be deducted from your paycheck.
