How your Dollars make a Difference

\$1 per pay period can provide medical teaching dolls to help explain a diagnosis to children.

\$1 per pay period enables a struggling family to be connected to a food pantry and another vital service like utility bill assistance – 24 hours a day.

\$1 per pay period could provide on the spot emergency assistance to 2 fire victims

FAQ

Federations, like all nonprofits, in order to function must cover basic operating expenses, which are kept to a minimum, so the majority of donations to go to their charities programs. Federations are regulated and must register with the State Attorney General, file annual IRS Form 990, and receive annual independent audit. Federations and their member charities are approved by your employer for inclusion in your workplace giving campaign.

WHY GIVE THROUGH PAYROLL DEDUCTION? Workplace campaigns are a very efficient form of non-profit fundraising. They are a proven cost-effective alternative to direct mail, telemarketing, annual fundraising drives and special event marketing.
